Controls

Power/Pair/Play/ Pause/Answer

Press and hold to power on/off

Press to play or pause an audio track

Volume -/ Previous

Press to increase volume

Power/Pair/Play/ Pause/Answer

Press twice to activate Bluetooth mode or soothing sounds

Press three times to disconnect Bluetooth

Volume +/Next

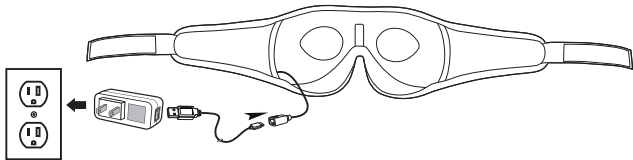
Press once to increase volume

Press and hold to go to the next track or nature sound

Charging the Battery

Requires a Micro-USB to USB cable (included). Charge fully before use.

1. Using a **Micro-USB to USB** cable (included), connect to the USB port of a powered-on computer or USB power adaptor (not included) to charge the unit.



Sleep Timer

1. Press the Volume + button twice to hear one beep and activate the sleep timer. The sleep timer will automatically turn off the device one hour after activation.
2. Press the Volume + button twice again to hear two beeps and deactivate the sleep timer.

Handsfree Calling

When connected to your phone via Bluetooth, press the **Power/Pair/Play/Pause/Answer** button to answer a call. Press the **Power/Pair/Play/Pause/Answer** button again to hang up.

Pairing a Bluetooth Device

1. Press and hold the **Power/Pair/Play/Pause/Answer** button to power on the unit. *When pairing, remain within 3 feet of the Bluetooth device.*
2. Using the controls on your Bluetooth device, select **IAHB33** in the Bluetooth Settings to pair. *If needed, refer to the user's manual for your specific device for more information.*
3. When successfully paired, a voice will announce, "Bluetooth connected." Your Bluetooth device will now be heard through the unit. Use the controls on the connected Bluetooth device to select and play audio.

After initial pairing, the unit will automatically connect to the last Bluetooth device used whenever it is powered on. If you would like to connect to a different device, turn off Bluetooth on the unwanted device or press the **Power/Pair/Play/Pause/Answer** button three times to disconnect from the current device and use the above steps to connect to a different device.

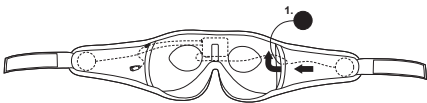
Nature Sounds

Press the **Power/Pair/Play/Pause/Answer** button twice to play one of the nature sound selections. Use the **Next** and **Previous** buttons to switch between sounds.

There are ten nature sound options:

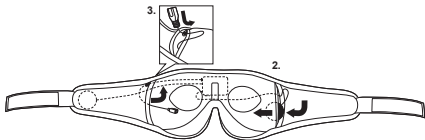
1. Campfire
2. Birds singing
3. Crashing waves
4. Gentle stream
5. Bubbling
6. Thunderstorm
7. Crashing waves and birds singing
8. Crashing waves and bubbling
9. Light music
10. Light rain

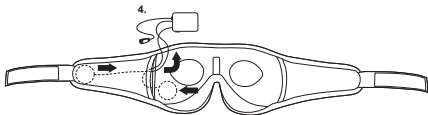
Controller and Earphone Removal



1. Carefully slide the right earphone out of the right side of the mask.
2. Tuck the right earphone into the inner pocket of the mask front

3. Remove the power cord from the left side of the mask. Pull the cord gently through the fabric loop, as seen on the diagram to the right.





4. Remove the controls from the mask front by sliding them out of the left opening. Gently pull the right earphone through the mask and out of the same opening.

5. Carefully pull the left earphone out of the left side of the mask.

To reinsert the earphones and controls, reverse the order of the removal steps.



Washing Instructions

Important: Do not wash this product with the electronic components still inside! They must be removed, or damage and injury may result. See previous sections on speaker removal.

Machine washing is not recommended for this product.

Hand wash only. Do not tumble dry in a dryer. Do not dry clean.

1. Remove the electronic components before getting wet.
2. Wash in temperatures below 104° F (40° C). Do not use bleach.
3. Reshape while damp. Lay flat to dry.
4. If wrinkles and shape distortion occur, use an iron on a low setting to flatten your mask.
