



Toilet Seat Cleaning

Toilet seats should be cleaned using a mild hand soap and water. Antibacterial hand soap or dish soap can be used to fight against germs.

Do not use bleach, pine oils, essential oils, chlorine, acid, scouring powders, detergents, disinfectants, or products in aerosol cans.

Harsh chemicals can rub away the paint finish on toilet seats and the metal finish on hinges. This can create a dull look on plastic toilet seats and a dirty worn-away look on enameled wood seats as well as corrosion and peeling of the metal hinge finish.
